Introduction

La Cruz is the tenth canton of the province of Guanacaste, established in 1969. It borders Nicaragua to the north and contains the main border crossing between the countries (Peñas Blancas).

La Cruz is located on the shores of what is now known as the Mirador de La Cruz, from where you can see wonderful and impressive sunsets in which the sun hides in the Pacific Ocean, on the wide horizon. This viewpoint and the Santa Rosa National Park are its main tourist attractions. The Casona de Santa Rosa is a special destination, a monument to the history of the country that has been preserved since the mid-nineteenth century. The beaches of La Cruz are wonderful, with the best-known options including: Soley, Rajadita, Copal and Pilas. Santa Rosa has some of the most beautiful beaches in Costa Rica.

 The city of La Cruz is located in the extreme north of the province of Guanacaste, just 40 minutes (58.6 km) from Liberia.

Tour to Santa Rosa

Santa Rosa National Park is a mixture of history and nature, located in Guanacaste and considered a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

The scene of the historic battle of March 20, 1856, Santa Rosa National Park is the only protected wilderness area that has a historical museum within its territory.

This site preserves the only patch of tropical dry forest in Mesoamerica. In addition, the area is closely connected to nearby rainforests and cloud forests, which help explain its incredible biological richness.

The park also contains some of the oldest land in Costa Rica, which emerged from the sea more than 85 million years ago.

City Tour La Cruz

Lookouts

Birdwatching

One of the main attractions in the La Cruz Coastal Tourism Corridor (CTC) is birdwatching. More than 200 species of birds can be observed in different habitats of the area including: primary dry tropical forest, secondary dry tropical forest, mangrove, open areas (savannah), marine areas (pelagic birds).

where you can observe the nesting of the frigate bird and some pelicans. This beautiful area of the country possesses a rich avian fauna, from birds of prey to hummingbirds.

Hiking

Roca Bruja (Witch's Rock), is a beach that has earned its reputation as a truly excellent surfing beach, with unbeatable conditions that all come together at the same time. Playa Junquillal to Playa Rajada is a 35.9 kilometer there-and-back trail with light traffic located near La Cruz, Guanacaste, Costa Rica. It has beautiful wildflowers and is rated moderate. The trail offers a number of different activities.

Santa Rosa Lookout via Río Cuajiniquil is a 13.2 kilometer there-and-back trail located

near La Cruz, Guanacaste, Costa Rica. It has a river and is rated moderate. The trail offers a number of different activities.

Rincón de la Vieja National Park

It offers a series of trails that will lead you to various points of volcanic interest, which include the trail to the Rincón de la Vieja and Von Seebach craters, the trail to Escondidas and La Cangreja waterfalls, the 3 km long Las Pailas trail, the trail to the Río Blanco pool, and the trail to the Bosque Encantado waterfall. This circuit of trails offers visitors the ability to immerse themselves

in the dry forest. The paths are well marked and are suitable for all.

Hacienda Guachipelin

The hotel has targeted its services to visitors looking to spend time practicing adventure sports and relaxing. The property offers 41 km of trails which are suitable for all levels. The destination includes wooded areas, rivers and waterfalls.

Vandara (ziplining, water slides, hot springs)

We'll enjoy riding for about 20 minutes, after which we will fly over the treetops 8 times on the ziplines. After the adrenaline rush, we will be greeted with delicious bread baked in a wood-fired oven and exquisite coffee prepared in a very traditional style.

The adventure continues on a 1,200 ft (400 m) water slide, after which we will enjoy the soothing properties of volcanic mud that you can spread all over your face and body and then rinse off in a river. You can relax in the swimming pool that naturally heats the volcanic hot springs. To finish, there is a delicious lunch prepared with vegetables

planted on the organic farm plus a main course from the menu.

There is a 30-minute stop included on the way to the hotel to buy souvenirs.



The "El Bosque Nuevo" butterfly farm is situated on 91 hectares of land along the road that leads to El Caoba, a community in the Santa Cecilia district. Since it is located on the slopes of the Volcán Orosi, the climate makes it an ideal site for growing pupae of different species of butterflies. This unique butterfly farm was established here for this very reason and has been operating for approximately seven years. Come see the incredible quantities of butterflies that fly in the surrounding jungle, which thrive in its cool mountain climate.

Our butterfly project, the Bosque Nuevo Butterfly Farm, involves teaching residents of our farm and the surrounding countryside how to sustainably grow and harvest butterfly pupae for sale in greenhouses around the world.

La Cruz is the tenth canton of Guanacaste. The main tourist sites are Santa Rosa National Park, the coastal area of Junquillal, Cuajiniquil, Jobo, Rajada, Salinas and Manzanillo Bay.


The canton is home to coastal communities that make their living from fishing, the rural environments of La Garita and Santa Cecilia, and La Cruz, its central district, with an altitude of 212 meters above sea level and a special view of the sunset.

Road access:

- Via the Carretera Interamericana, 20 kilometers from the Peñas Blancas border crossing on the Nicaraguan border.
- The coastal road, a project on the border with Nicaragua, near San Juan del Sur
- Route 04 North-Atlantic Corridor, linking La Cruz with Upala, San Carlos, Guápiles and Limón.
